#### The RoboVikes Went To China!



Over November's Thanksgiving Break, a team of 27 parents and mentors traveled to China to spread the message of FIRST. Our team members had a great time sharing our passion for STEM and robotics abroad.

At the Beijing Economic Management School (BEMS), the RoboVikes taught the students how to build a simple robot by walking them through step by step and building it with them. After we built the robot, both the RoboVikes and the BEMS students exchanged culture, which included a martial arts presentation from the Chinese students and a square dancing presentation from the American students.

The RoboVIkes also got the chance to visit the High School affiliated with Shanghai Jiao Tong University where we met FRC Team 5515, Blue

Power Robotics. The students from both teams exchanged knowledge and ideas about robotics in order to have a more efficient build season and grow in our communities.

Along with visiting the schools, the RoboVike students were also able to experience the Great Wall of China, the Forbidden City, the Summer Palace, and even eating dinner in the Oriental Pearl Tower.
